2021 MATERIALS & SERVICES CHARGE

For 2021 the Governing Council has approved the Materials & Services Charge. All the compulsory costs associated with your son/daughter's secondary schooling are included in the total M&S Charge including subject charges for the whole year (some exceptions apply).

The figures are consistent with the current level of expenditure required to support our curriculum and give students at Mount Compass School the best possible educational resources.

THE M&S CHARGE INCLUDES:

◆ All compulsory, curriculum related excursions R-12	◆ Consumables and use of equipment
◆ Textbook hire	◆ Access to the Internet and networked computers
◆ All stationery for Years R-6	◆ Initial allocation of printing & costs of internet downloads
◆ An initial stationery pack for Years 7-12	◆ Access to Library resources

Payments by instalment can be arranged. Easy direct debit payments can be made with the CBA's secure payment portal BPoint. Forms will be available on Fee Collection Day to set up this easy payment method.

2021 SCHOOL CARD SCHEME

WHAT'S NEW?

Applicants who apply for School Card assistance via an ED003A - Income Audit application form will need to complete the online application form. The online application form is available at www.sa.gov.au under the heading **Education, Skills and Learning** or we can assist you at the school.

Parents/caregivers need to re-apply for School Card assistance for each year. By completing the ED003A application form online, the application form will be emailed directly to the government school(s) where the child(ren) attend, i.e. where two children attend different schools both sites will receive a copy of the application form.

School Card income limits for 2021 will be advised as soon as possible. The rates are based on your combined family gross income for the financial year **2019/2020, NOT YOUR CURRENT INCOME.**

Please note by applying online, each school where you have children attending will be notified.

Parents/caregivers who do not apply for School Card assistance by the above date will be required to pay the total amount of the prescribed school charge. Parents/caregivers who qualify within the combined family gross income limits will both be required to sign the 2021 forms. This is a Centrelink audit requirement. The school's finance staff will assist you regarding these requirements.

If you have any questions relating to the School Card application forms we invite you to contact the school's Finance Officer Mrs Janette Potter from 11 January 2021.

Income limits for 2021 eligibility will be advised as soon as they are released from the department.

STUDENT ID CARDS

At MCAS, our students use their ID Cards to borrow books and resources from the library as well as for printing access. The card cost is included in the M & S Charge. Information on the card includes the student's photo, date of birth, and school library barcode number. Benefits of having a student ID card include: easy identification for the Passenger Transport Board; student travel concessions; concessions for any entrance fees for students & general identification. NB: replacement card cost \$9.90 incl GST.
